"ARTE IN MEMORIA" BIENNALE AT OSTIA



Sunday, January 22nd will inaugurate the ninth edition of "Arte in Memoria" (Art in Memory), an international biennale of contemporary art created and curated by Adachiara Zevi and organized by the Associazione Culturale Arteinmemoria, at the Synagogue in Ostia Antica. The show will be open to the public until April 18th and has the support of both the German Embassy and the Cultural Office of the Embassy of Israel. The exhibit plays host to many artists who create works specifically for the Synagogue of Ostia, the oldest synagogue in

the west, dating back to the first century A.D. Some of these highlighted artists include Sara Enrico, famous for her weavings of modern synthetic fibers utilizing painting, craftsmanship and technology, Horst Hoheisel, busy participating in restoration work on the synagogue by capturing memories that the ruins evoke in himself, Ariel Schlesinger, and Luke Bonnet. Art in Memory commemorates Remembrance day, a day established by several European countries and fixed for the day the gates of Auschwitz opened. The project's goal is to find continuity in time, connecting the artists' timely topics and point of view in modern day, back to the historical memory.
